

#### Useful INFOS

Cows emit methane, a gas about 30 times more harmful to the atmosphere than CO2. Methane is responsible for 53% of nitrous oxide emissions and 44% of methane emissions.



In addition, to produce 1 kg of beef would require 550 L of water compared to 228 L of water for 1 kg of grain products, or 58.54% less.

Cleaning your mailbox regularly is a gesture accessible to all, which helps to some extent to reduce digital pollution. Digital production and consumption account for 3.7% of global greenhouse gas emissions.



An email with an attachment can emit 19g of CO2. Storing an email in a data center for one year emits 10g of CO2. One stored email results in 30g of CO2 emissions. And in the world, 281 billion emails are sent every day.
