WHEN TO REGISTER

Enrollment starts on December 3rd and ends December 19th!

All enrollments on the Google Form are final. Your selection is final and will be charged to your account once the class is confirmed i.e. meets the minimum required number. You are still welcome to enroll your students in an Enrichment Class if there are spots available after the registration deadline.

Note that an automatic \$25 late registration fee will be applied after the deadline.

CLASS CONFIRMATION

Classes will be confirmed and charged on your portal as soon as the minimum number required is met. All classes will be confirmed and charged by December 19th. If a class needs to be canceled due to low enrollment, no charge will be deducted. You will be contacted directly if a class has been cancelled. If a class has exceeded the maximum capacity a waitlist will be formed. You will be contacted directly if you have been placed on the waitlist.

REFUND POLICY

There will be no full refund nor credits once a class is charged on your portal.

In case of a child's absence due to medical or any other reason including but not limited to: quarantine, sickness, conflict in schedule, travel, etc, no refund/credit can be allowed in order to secure the continuity of the class for the rest of the group. In case of Field trips (overnight or day trip), there will be no credit applied as classes MUST run due to a mix of grades in each enrichment class.

What is it?

Aviation and aerospace are set to explode over the next 20+ years—with new aircraft, drones, eVTOLs (electric vertical takeoff and landing aircrafts), and space technologies creating huge demand for engineers, designers, operators, and entrepreneurs. This club is a hands-on lab where students can explore that future now.

- What you'll do Meet weekly in a student-driven "innovation lab" where you and your friends pick topics you care about—airlines, drones, eVTOLs, airports, or aerospace startups—and turn them into projects.
- **What you'll learn** Understand different career pathways in aviation and aerospace (engineering, operations, business, design, entrepreneurship), and how they connect.
- Who this is for Middle and high school students who are curious about aviation, technology, or startups and want a fun, collaborative, real-world space to experiment with ideas and see where the next 20+ years of aerospace might take them.

At the end of the program, FAA students and their parents will get the opportunity to participate in a Saturday group visit of the Princeton Airport, and discover their the flight training and aircraft maintenance operations.

Model United Nations Club

The Model UN Club is an academic club that parallels the processes of the United Nations. Student delegates take on the role of real and fictionalized people or countries to solve real world problems through oral arguments, debate, negotiation, and consensus building. This club helps students develop a global and historical awareness of the world. Each week, the students will practice these skills through engaging games and activities.

They will learn and practice the procedures utilized during Model UN Conferences. We plan to attend a tri-state area Middle School Model UN conference and hope to attend an out of state conference as well. MSMUN is an academic club that may require students to complete assignments at home. If your child is interested in joining the Model UN Club, they must submit one paragraph expressing why they would like to be a part of the Model UN Club. Students will be selected based upon availability and their commitment to the club, as demonstrated in their responses.

This class is designed for students who already know the basics of knitting and are ready for more challenging work. They will learn to read multi-step patterns, explore advanced techniques such as shaping, colorwork, and texture, and complete a full-piece project for the trimester. Students will gain confidence and independence as they manage their own projects and troubleshoot along the way.

The class is taught in French and English by Julie Lagauzere, a professional knitter and one of our FAA parents.

A minimum of 5 students is necessary to open the class. (Max 12 students)

- What you'll do Fly training missions on a Cessna 172, and then move to more advanced aircraft for complex missions in our flight simulator, explore how a flight PC and cockpit hardware are assembled, and join <u>field trips to Princeton Airport and Micro Center.</u>
- What you'll learn How airplanes fly, the basics of instruments, navigation and weather, plus problem-solving, focus and confidence from making real-time pilot decisions.
- Who this is for Middle and high school students who love planes or tech and want a structured first step toward pilot training or future studies in aviation and aerospace.



Each session combines skill drills with small-sided games to give students hands-on practice and immediate opportunities to apply what they've learned.

The class emphasizes personal growth, sportsmanship, and confidence, helping students develop both their soccer abilities and teamwork skills in a supportive environment.

In this more advanced enrichment, students will continue to develop core skills—dribbling, passing, shooting, and man-to-man defense—and will also work on fast breaks, set plays, spacing, and overall basketball IQ. Coach Flo brings solid experience from coaching youth basketball in Europe (U11 to U15). Middle School Students will have the opportunity to join the FAA Dolphins team, which competes in the Hudson League in the fall and will take part in the Chicago Tournament in March, bringing together French-American schools from across North America. High School students may have the opportunity to compete in friendly games against other schools as we develop our varsity team.

A minimum of 10 students is necessary to open the class. If this class exceeds the maximum 2 groups will form. (Max 16 students per group)

Dans cet enrichissement plus avancé, les élèves continueront à développer les compétences fondamentales — dribble, passe, tir et défense individuelle — et travailleront également sur les contre-attaques, les systèmes de jeu, l'espacement sur le terrain et la compréhension générale du jeu (basketball IQ). L'entraîneur Flo apporte une solide expérience acquise en entraînant des équipes de jeunes en Europe (U11 à U15). Les élèves du collège auront l'opportunité de rejoindre l'équipe des FAA Dolphins, qui participe à la Hudson League à l'automne et au tournoi de Chicago en mars, réunissant les écoles franco-américaines de toute l'Amérique du Nord. Les lycéens pourraient avoir l'occasion de participer à des matchs amicaux contre d'autres écoles, dans le cadre du développement de notre équipe varsity.

Virtual Reality Design and Creation

With Metanaut Academy

10 classes

Cost: \$400



Students embark on a journey to create and share location based AR art around the building. Utilizing the same software used to make Incredible AR games like Pokemon Go and Harry Potter's Wizarding World. Students will build their own shareable AR artwork viewable via Niantics WebAR protocol, 8th wall, on all devices with a web connection.

Students will create works of art using emerging technology, the Meta Quest VR headset, where they will also play fun and educational VR and AR games. In addition, students will learn about 3d design, intellectual property, digital goods, NFTs, digital citizenship, and internet etiquette.

A minimum of 4 students is necessary to open the class. (Max 6 students)
